- Chief Justice of the Idaho Supreme Court
- Received his Bachelors of Science degree in Finance from the University of Colorado in 1970 and graduated from the University of Idaho School of Law with a Jurs Doctorate in 1974.
- Has worked as a bank examiner with the Idaho Department of Finance; with the law firm of Webb, Pike, Burton & Carlson in Twin Falls; as Deputy Prosecuting Attorney in Ada County; and as a partner with the law firm of Hart and Burdick, in Jerome.
- Elected as Prosecuting Attorney for Jerome County in 1980. Served as Magistrate Judge in Jerome County from 1981 to 1993.
- President of the District Judges Association from 2001 to 2003.
- In 2003, he was appointed the Administrative Judge for the Fifth Judicial District. Finally in August 2003, he was appointed to be the fifth Chief Justice of the Idaho Supreme Court by Governor Dirk Kempthorne.
