



Frequently Asked Questions

1. What time can I set up?

Food Vendors: Sunday, July 3, 2011 between 6-9 pm and Monday, July 4, 2011 between 7-10 am
MUST BE SET UP AND READY BY 10 AM, July 4th, 2011 - and all vehicles need to be off Memorial Drive by 10 AM as well.

Business Vendors: Monday, July 4, between 7-10am

MUST BE SET UP AND READY BY 10 AM - and all vehicles need to be off Memorial Drive by 10 AM.

2. What is my assigned location?

Food Vendors: An email will be sent out to all vendors which will include your vendor number and layout/map. All food vendors are located along the CURB on the west side of Memorial Drive. Your tent/trailer needs to be set up facing the river as most activities are located on the greenbelt. Your designated number will also be painted on the street. Per the fire marshall we must have 15 ft between each food vendor. Please keep your trailer/tent between the painted lines. **An event staffer will also be on hand to help you locate your spot.**

Business Vendors: An email will be sent to all vendors which will include your vendor number and layout/map. All business vendors will be located on the GREENBELT. Your number will be painted on the grass. **An event staffer will also be on hand to help you locate your spot.**

3. When must I be torn down?

Food Vendors: Power will be shut off at 10 pm. You can tear down any time after that.

Business Vendors: Teardown MUST be completed BY 6 pm

4. Parking/Delivery of Supplies

A parking permit will be emailed out. Please print and place this permit on the dashboard of every vehicle involved in setup/take-down. Parking is to be located on Legion Drive and in the Bonneville County Courthouse parking lots. **No tow/supply vehicles will be allowed on Memorial Drive between the hours of 10am-5pm. If you need help delivery supplies, ice, etc., please contact a committee member and they will assist you with a 4-wheeler.**

5. Power/Water Access for Food Vendors:

Power needs were indicated on your registration form and arrangements have been made. If you require power that you did not pre-request, a fee of \$100 will be billed to you by Wheeler Electric. **If, for any reason, your power fails or your breaker trips, please contact Erroll Gillman, Service Technician for Wheeler Electric at 208-589-0411. DO NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, ATTEMPT TO RESET OR MODIFY YOUR OWN POWER! Any service calls generated that are caused by your operation will be billed to you.**

6. Will there be ice available?

An ice trailer will be available for those food vendors that need ice at \$3/ea for a 20 lb bag. Please contact a committee member if you need ice delivered to you.

Items you will need during the course of the event (food vendors):

- Extension Cords
- Restaurant-grade hose for water
- K Class Fire Extinguisher
- Copy of Health Department Temporary Food Permit (The Health Dept. will be checking for permits during the event, so please have your permit displayed.)
- 2 x 6 wood to level your trailer
- Bag of sand in case there is water at the curb.
