

# Target School Spree Chaperone Instructions

Thank you for serving as a chaperone for the Target School Spree. Read below for directions and shopping tips!

- Check-in with The Salvation Army to receive a nametag and supplies. The Salvation Army will pair you with a child for the Target School Spree.
- Each child is allocated an \$80 GiftCard to spend. You will be in charge of using the GiftCard at the checkout aisle. Please pre-calculate your child's purchases to ensure you do not exceed the \$80 limit. ***The cashiers will collect the gift card from the chaperone/child after the transaction (see below for further instruction).***
- Review the Parental Consent Form. This form tells you the needs and sizes of the child - use it for assistance during the shopping spree.
- Start shopping! Guide the child to the Boys or Girls departments, sale and clearance racks and locate any special shopping request listed on the Parental Consent Form. Please be conscious of the time and complete shopping by the designated hour.
- The GiftCard should be used on school supplies and clothing. Please use your discretion on other items as you shop.
- DO NOT TAKE ANY CHILD INTO THE FITTING ROOMS UNLESS A THIRD PARTY (ADULT) IS PRESENT**
- When you are ready to make your final purchase, take all the merchandise to the register and assist the child with the check-out process.
- At the end of the transaction, the cashier will collect the gift card. Any remaining balances on these cards will be transferred on to one gift card and given to the chapter/community center contact for them to use for other school related needs the chapter/community center identifies.***
- Return the Parental Consent Form and shopping receipts to The Salvation Army.
- If available, take your child to post-spree event in the food service area at the front of the store.
